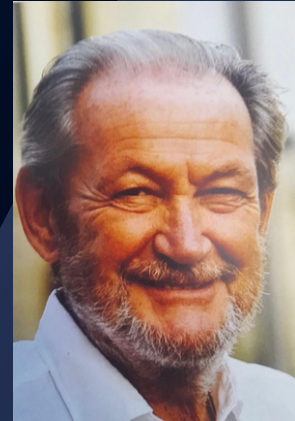

The Story of Valentino Balboni

“The Miura, guys, needs no further words or comments. Anything more that is said is superfluous. By now, the Miura is everything.

I started working at Lamborghini in 1968: I was an apprentice mechanic and I washed many parts with a brush, gasoline, and a scraper. Then, in 1973, with the increase in production, there was a need to prepare two more test drivers. I had submitted a request, and they knew that I liked to drive. I worked for about a year with Bob.



I tested one of the last Miura SVs; it was 1973. For a guy just over twenty years old, it was a truly beautiful experience to work in a company like that.

Sixty years have passed and I am still always among cars... rather, among Lamborghinis, which are not just cars, but something much more...”

A Lamborghini Experience

This is not simply a road trip.

It is a Lamborghini driving experience created to honor one of the most iconic cars in automotive history: the Miura.

Over four days, a limited number of crews will travel through Italy's Motor Valley along routes selected for driving pleasure, scenic beauty and historical significance. Each stage of the journey combines three essential elements of the Lamborghini world.

- Heritage: the places where the legend was born
- Performance: dynamic experiences connected to Lamborghini's racing DNA
- Italian Lifestyle: hospitality, gastronomy, and refined atmosphere

This is not only about driving.

It is about becoming part of Lamborghini history, even if only for a few days.





Day 1

Welcome to the Legend

Guests arrive in Bologna and are transferred to a premium countryside hotel near the city, offering secure parking and dedicated event hospitality.

In the late afternoon, the official welcome takes place, including a program presentation and the first meeting with Valentino Balboni.

The evening continues with a gourmet welcome dinner celebrating the excellence of Italian cuisine.





Day 2

Where Lamborghini is Born

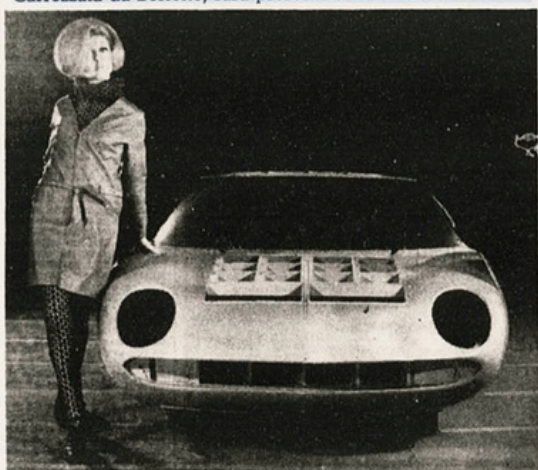
A scenic drive leads to Sant'Agata Bolognese, home of Automobili Lamborghini. Guests enjoy a private visit to the Lamborghini factory and museum, exploring the evolution of the brand from the Miura to today's hybrid super sports cars.

The journey continues with a guided visit to the Ferruccio Lamborghini Museum, followed by a traditional Bolognese lunch.

In the afternoon, the group visits a renowned Italian coachbuilding atelier, a symbol of automotive craftsmanship and bespoke artistry.

Dinner is hosted in Bologna's historic city center.

Carrozzeria da Bertone, sarà presentata al Salone di Ginevra

La macchina, il cui telaio era stato esposto all'ultimo Salone di Torino, si avvale di una meccanica eccezionale, in quanto il motore a dodici cilindri a V è sistemato posteriormente ed in senso trasversale, il che comporta tutta una serie di soluzioni nuove sia nella meccanica che nella carrozzeria: per esempio l'intera parte posteriore (che contiene anche lo spazio per i bagagli) si può sollevare a idraulica staccare per da-

rali; il motore di 4000 cmc di cilindrata ha una potenza di 350 oppure 430 CV secondo le versioni.

E' evidente che nell'edizione più spinta la vettura si presta all'impiego in competizione, ed a tale scopo verrà approntato un esemplare particolarmente alleggerito e preparato, che potrà partecipare alla «24 Ore» di Le Mans del prossimo anno, se le prove in corso confermeranno le buone doti di stabilità e velocità che i progettisti si erano prefissi.

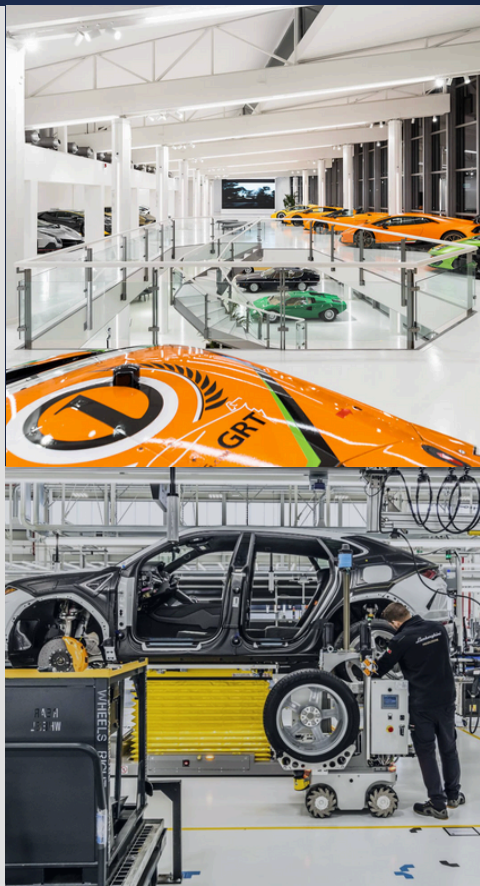

The day continues at the Modena Circuit with a professionally managed on-track driving experience in Lamborghini Huracán Super Trofeo race cars, under the supervision of professional instructors.

An exclusive evening gathering in a unique setting, designed to celebrate the spirit, passion, and character that define Lamborghini.





Day 4

Grand Finale: History, Speed & Celebration

Transfer to the legendary Autodromo Enzo e Dino Ferrari in Imola.

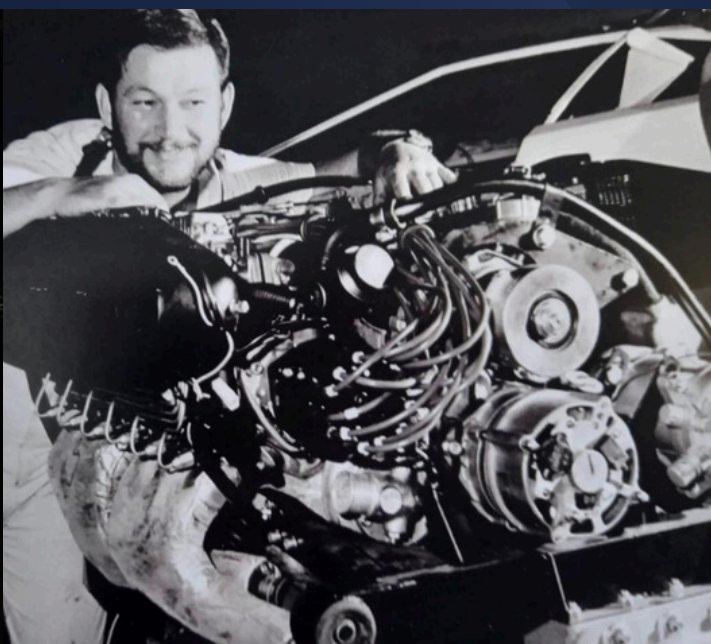
Guests will access the paddock and hospitality areas of the Lamborghini Arena, experiencing the atmosphere of a major motorsport event from behind the scenes. This includes dedicated spaces, vehicle displays, and an insider perspective on Lamborghini's presence in the world of high-performance competition.

After lunch, the group returns to Bologna for a guided cultural visit through the historic city center.

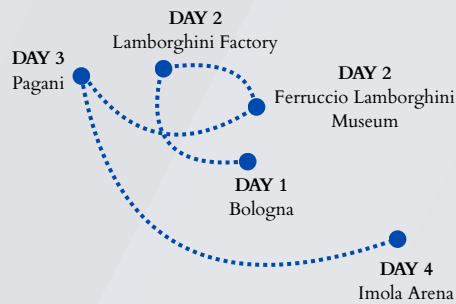
Farewell Grand Gala Evening
